

How to Join Piping, for a Perfect Ending!

1. Begin in the center of one edge and start sewing 1" from the end of the piping. Stitch to within 1" of the corner, stop and snip into the seam allowance of the piping. This allows it to "turn" the corner. Continue stitching until you reach the beginning.



2. Using your seam ripper, rip back about 1" of the piping fabric to expose the cord on one end.



3. Trim the cord on this end, so the two ends of cord meet.



4. Stop about 2" from the end. Cut off the excess piping leaving 1" overlap.



5. Fold under the "empty" end of fabric and wrap the fabric around the end with the cord, to join the ends. Stitch.
