

CARTON COZY

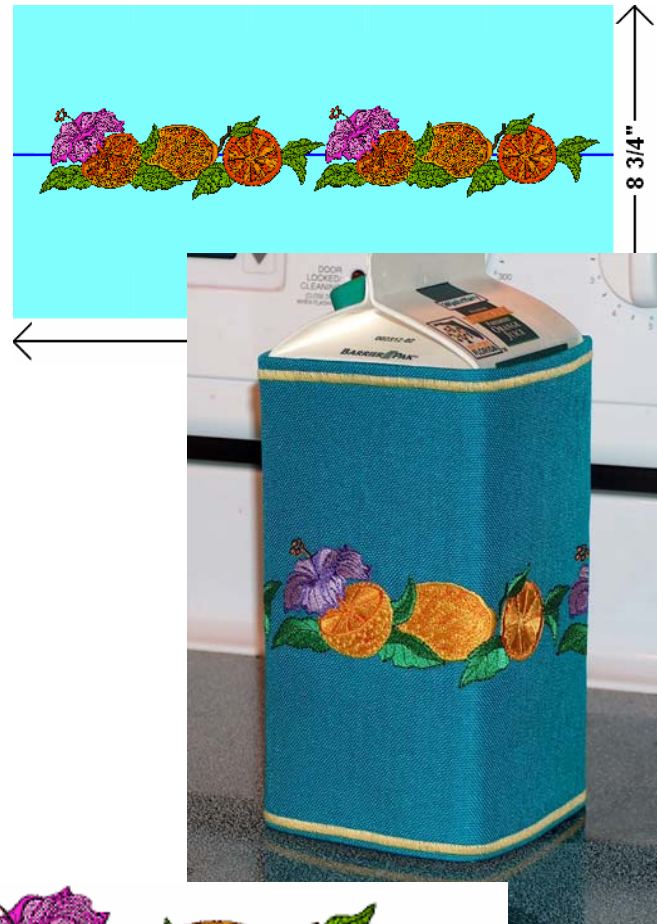

Our carton cozy will keep your juice “dressed” & chilled for breakfast time! Customize your cozy for milk or other carton drinks. Your beverages can sit on the table during meals and stay chilled.

Supplies You'll Need:

- Pfaff creative 2170
- Pfaff creative cd 376 Tropical Paradise
- 1 – 16 ½” x 8 ¾” canvas or other tightly-woven fabric (the design is colored as limes – just substitute shades of orange to turn those limes into oranges!)
- 1 – 15 ½” x 7 ¾” thin Puffy Foam (the Puffy Foam will give the sleeve body and keep it from slipping off your cartons!)
- 1 – 15 ½” x 7 ¾” fusible web
- Rayon embroidery threads, metallic embroidery threads
- Regular sewing thread to match fabric
- Temporary fusible tear-away stabilizer (or substitute regular tear-away and temporary spray adhesive)



Let's Get Started:

1. Download your design to the memory of your machine.
2. Hoop a piece of stabilizer.
3. Fuse the Puffy Foam centered on the back of the woven fabric.
4. Draw a line down the center length of the fabric. Position the fabric so the top edge is even with the top inner edge of the hoop and the drawn line is aligned with the notches on the top and bottom edges of the hoop.

5. Embroider your chosen design centered on the line and as close to the top edge of the hoop as possible.
6. Remove from hoop and reposition fabric to stitch a second motif below the first.
7. Remove excess stabilizer and press.
8. With right sides facing, use a ½" seam allowance to stitch the narrow ends together to form a tube.
9. Fold over the ½" top and bottom seam allowance and topstitch in place (I used a narrow satin stitch to give my cozy a nice accent edge in a coordinating thread color).
