

## GRAND TOILET SEAT COVER

Designed and created especially for Pfaff

Embroider a touch of elegance for your bathroom. Pfaff's creative Grand Hoop is the perfect tool for quickly stitching up our custom-embroidered toilet-seat cover.

### Supplies You'll Need:

- Pfaff creative 2170
- Pfaff creative GRAND Hoop...you can stitch each motif in the standard 140mm x 225mm hoop, but using the Pfaff creative Grand Hoop will result in half the hooping!
- Pfaff creative cd 373 Grand Elegance
- 1 – 21" square ea of batting, outer and lining fabrics
- 1 pkg ½" wide double-fold bias
- ¼" elastic (the circumference of your toilet seat + 4" – will be cut to size)
- Rayon embroidery threads
- Sewing thread to match fabric



### Let's Get Started:

1. Trace the outline of your toilet seat onto a large piece of paper. Add 1" all around edges.
2. Download your designs (including the ESQ file) to your machine memory.
3. Layer the lining, batting and fabric and hoop, centered in your Grand Hoop. Attach the hoop to the machine.
4. Following the instructions on the machine, embroider both halves of your design in the center of the fabric/batting sandwich.
5. Remove from hoop and press.
6. Trace around pattern, centering embroidery.

7. Use a narrow zigzag stitch to stitch along traced line to secure all layers together.
8. Turn under and hem the flat edge at the back of the seat.
9. Bind outer curved edge to create an elastic casing.
10. Run elastic through the casing. Place cover on seat and draw elastic up to fit snugly. Pin ends together, overlapping approximately 1". Elastic will run across the back edge of the inside of the seat.
11. Stitch through overlapped ends of elastic to secure.
