

## SIMPLE SACHETS

Designed and created especially for Pfaff

A beautiful Pfaff lace motif is just the embroidery to create a simple sachet. Our sachets are perfect for every room in your home and just great as a fragrant housewarming gift!

### Supplies You'll Need:

- Pfaff creative 2170
- Pfaff Rectangular hoop 115mm x 120mm
- Pfaff creative cd 364 Lace Renaissance
- 3 – 10" squares organza or fine netting
- Rayon embroidery thread...fill a bobbin to match
- Several layers of Paper Solvy® - I've selected Paper Solvy instead of heavyweight water-soluble stabilizer for this project as it's easier to rinse out.



### Let's Get Started:

**NOTE:** The secret to our sachet is selecting a design that stitches the final satin stitch around the outer perimeter of the design. If your selected motif doesn't have a final outer satin outline, you can edit it using Pfaff 3D Embroidery Artist software or manually satin-stitch the backing to the lace motif.

1. Hoop the stabilizer and lightly spray with temporary adhesive. Position 1 piece of the organza in the center of the hoop.
2. Send your design to the memory of your machine.
3. Embroider the lace motif up to the final outline stitches (the straight stitches and satin stitching that goes around the entire outside of the embroidery).
4. Remove hoop from the machine and lay the hooped fabric face-down on a flat surface.

5. Fold the 2 remaining pieces of organza in half. Overlap the folds 1". Pin the overlapped backing pieces to the embroidered piece, centering the overlap edges in the center of the embroidery.
6. Reattach hoop to machine and stitch the final satin-stitch outline to complete.
7. Remove from hoop and trim the outer fabric close to the satin-stitched outline, making sure to not snip through any of the threads.
8. Rinse out the excess stabilizer.
9. Stitch a small bow & loop at the top of the sachet.
10. Using small scraps of netting, create a small pouch full of potpourri to insert into the sachet through the overlap on the back of the sachet.
