

Skinny Scarves

Designed and created especially for Pfaff

Need a great last minute Holiday gift? Skinny scarves are all the rage...and you can create an original for everyone on your gift list...and a few for yourself! With just narrow strips of polar-fleece, rayon embroidery threads and your Pfaff creative Embroidery Machine, you'll soon have your Holiday list all wrapped up!



Supplies You'll Need:

- Pfaff creative Embroidery Machine
- Pfaff creative Card #317 Christmas
- Rayon embroidery thread
- 4" x 60" (or width of fleece) strip for each scarf – great way to use up those small leftover pieces from other projects!
- Tear-away stabilizer
- Temporary adhesive spray
- Water-soluble stabilizer – as a top layer on your embroidery to keep threads from burying into the fabric surface
- Fabric marker

Let's Get Started:

1. Hoop a piece of tear-away stabilizer and lightly spray with temporary adhesive.
2. Center the scarf piece in the middle of the hoop, leaving approximately 5"-6" hanging over the front of the hoop (this will be cut into fringe). Lay a piece of water-soluble stabilizer on top of the fleece in the area to be embroidered.
3. Embroider your selected motif in the center of the hoop – just make sure to select designs that are narrow enough



to fit (approx. 90mm or less). The design we selected, #14, has been reduced to it's smallest size and is just perfect for a scarf! Add a second motif to the opposite end if desired.

4. Remove from hoop and tear away all excess stabilizer.
5. With a fabric marker, mark fringe cutting lines on both ends of the scarf – approximately 5"-6" long and 1/4"-1/2" wide sections. Use very sharp shears or a rotary cutter and mat to cut the fringe.
6. Rinse out any remaining water-soluble stabilizer and markings.
