

Rolled Hem Foot

Machine Settings:
Thread tension: 4-5
Stitch length: 2-4
Foot pressure: 3-5

Use the Rolled Hem Foot to sew a narrow rolled hem in light to medium weight fabrics such as chiffon, silk or light weight cotton.

1. Press a double 1/8" (3mm) wide hem in the first inch of the hem.
2. Set the speed control slide at the left most (less speed) position.
3. Place the hem under the Rolled Hem foot with the pressed hem in the groove on the underside of the foot and stitch several stitches on the pressed hem.
4. Stop with the needle in the fabric, raise the presser foot and pull the fabric edge up into the scroll/guide on the foot.
5. Lower the presser foot and continue to sew. Do not help the fabric edge to roll, simply hold the edge vertically about 3" to 4" from the front of the foot.
