Elegant Tissue Holder

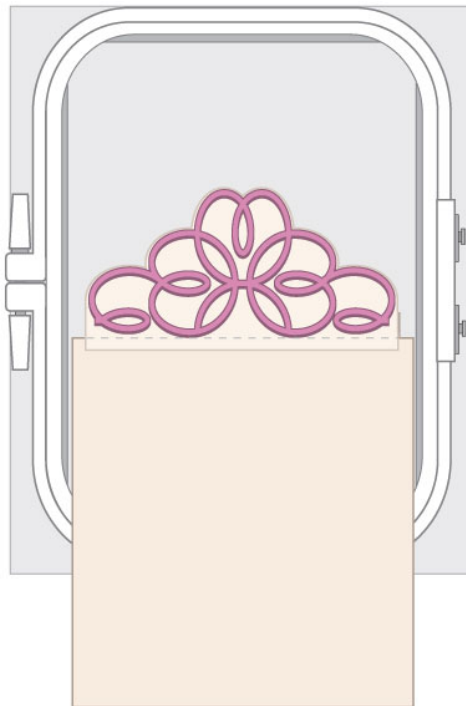
Make this beautiful embroidered tissue holder as a gift for all the important women in the wedding party. Keep the tears and make-up under control without having to carry a large tissue box!

SUPPLIES:

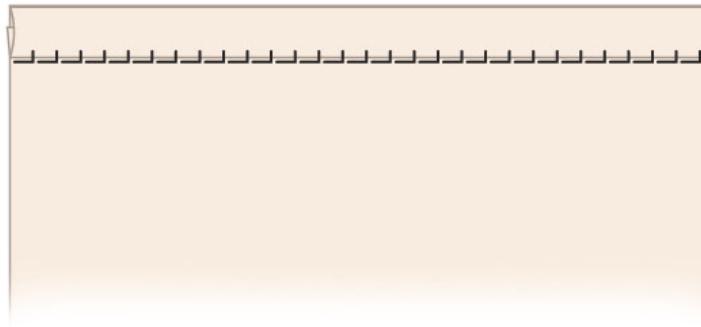
1/3" yard of dress-weight linen (color of choice)
Rayon thread (coordinating or complimentary colors)
White bobbin thread
Spray starch
Sticky stabilizer
Water-soluble stabilizer
Wing Needle, size #120
Water- or air-soluble marking pen
Pattern tracing material

INSTRUCTIONS:

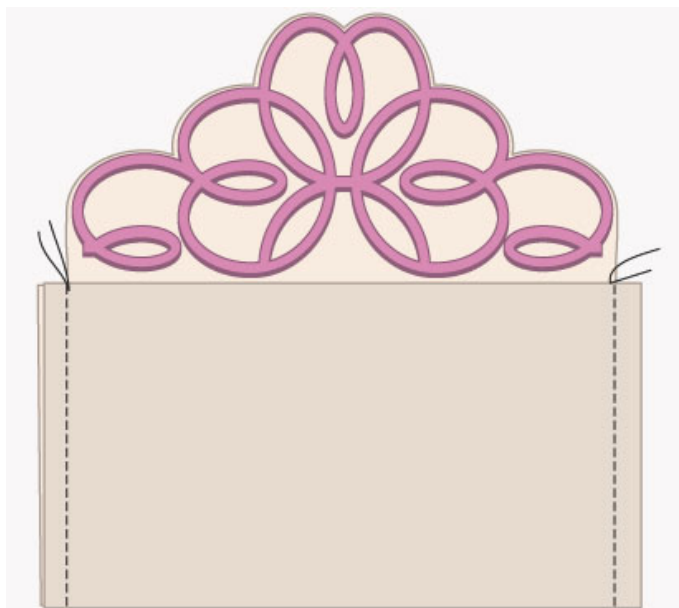
1. Cut a piece of linen 8 1/2" x 11". Spray the piece with starch and carefully press.
2. Center the pattern on the fabric and trace it onto the linen piece using the marking pen. Transfer any markings.
3. Set up your sewing machine for embroidery and attach the embroidery unit. Adhere sticky stabilizer to the back of your small embroidery hoop (120 X 115) and center the narrow end of the linen on top.
4. Select the embroidery design given here and begin stitching. Once the initial outline stitching has been completed, trim away the fabric from the outer edge of the design but do not tear-away the stabilizer.
5. Layer the water-soluble stabilizer over the cut-away edge and continue stitching the embroidery design.



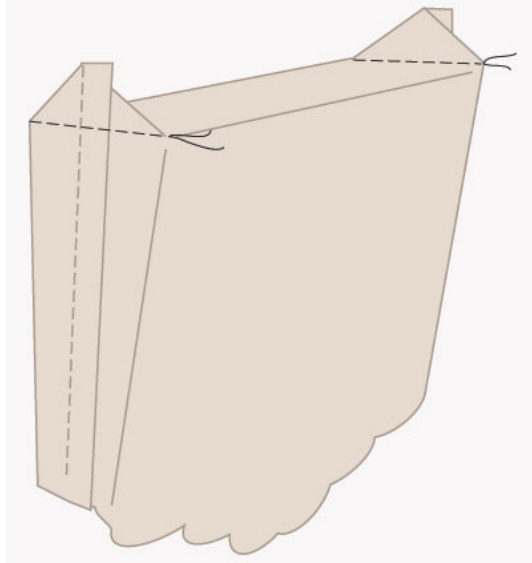
6. Once finished, remove the linen from the hoop and tear-away any stabilizer. (If any of the water-soluble stabilizer remains, it can be removed by dampening it with water.)
7. On the opposite end, turn in a 1/4" double-fold hem and press.
8. Using the Wing Needle, a hem stitch (stitch #18 on the Pfaff *creative* 2140), and your Narrow Edge Foot, stitch close to the turned in edge guiding the foot along the fold.



9. With right sides together, turn up the hemmed edge to the foldline, matching edges. Stitch a 1/4" seam on each side forming a pocket.



10. Square the bottom corners to hold the tissue better. (A full packet of Kleenex® tissue will fit in this tissue holder.)



11. Turn to the right side and use!
