

SCRAPPY CAT

A cat that doesn't require feeding, doesn't shed and works with the rest of your décor! These are so quick and easy, you'll love making an entire litter to grace your home.

Supplies You'll Need:

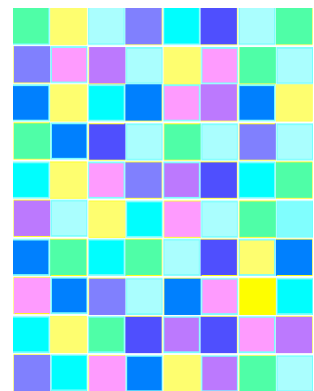
- Pfaff sewing machine
- ¼" Quilting Foot w/IDT
- 80 – 2 ½" squares of miscellaneous cotton fabrics
- Polyfil for stuffing cushion
- Regular thread for needle and bobbin



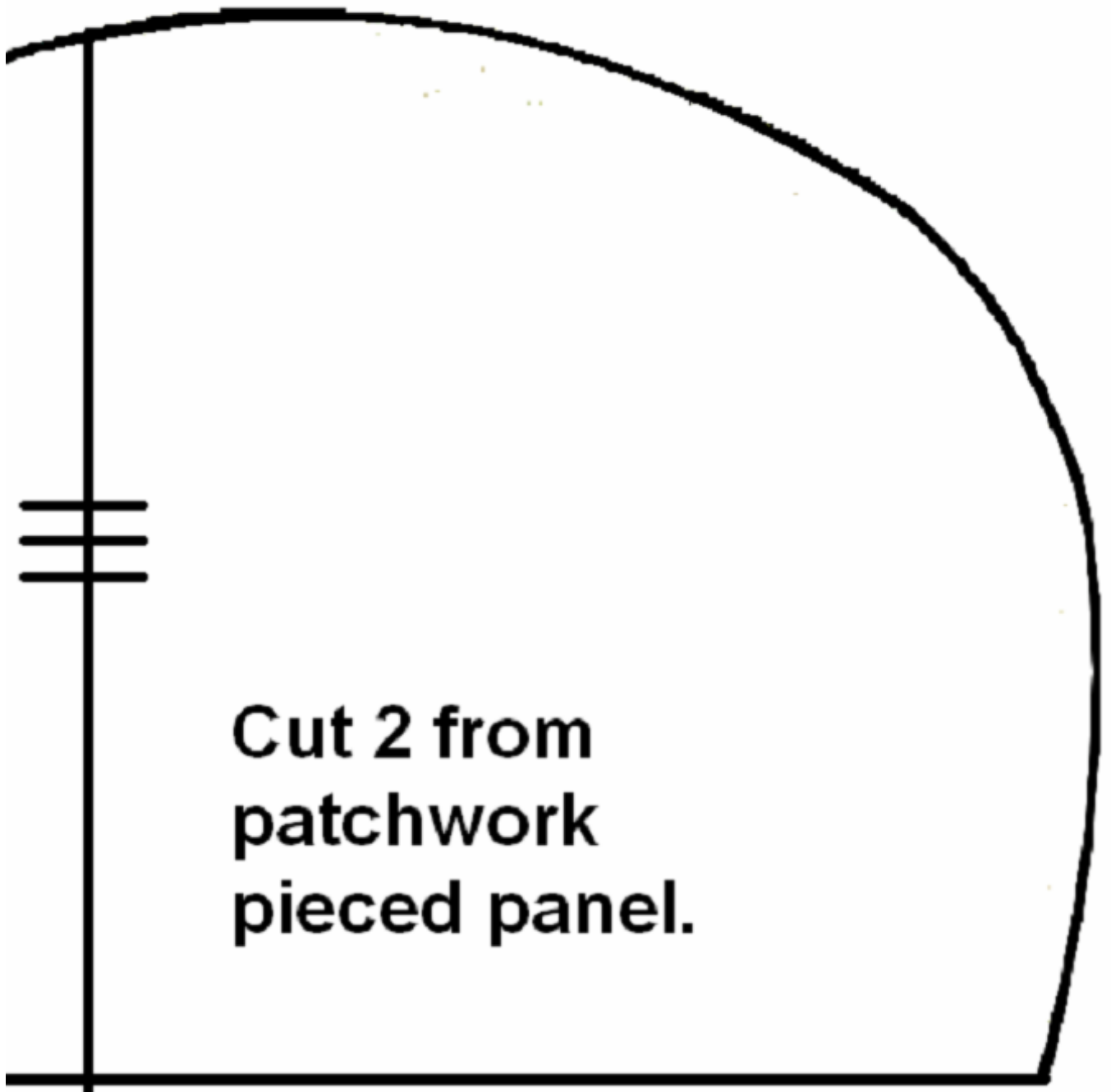
NOTE: all seams are ¼".

Let's Get Started:

1. From all your miscellaneous fabric scraps, cut 80 – 2 ½" squares.
2. Using a ¼" seam allowance, stitch the squares together in an 8 x 10 row grid. Press.
3. OPTIONAL: Add any decorative stitching or other embellishment at this point.
4. Cut out and tape together pattern on notched line.
5. From pattern, cut two pieces from your patchwork fabric panel. Due to all the seam allowances, it is easier to cut two separate pieces rather than folding the panel in half. Just make sure you cut one facing each direction.
6. With right sides together, stitch around the outer edge, leaving an opening at the bottom for turning and stuffing.
7. Clip curves, turn right side out and press.
8. Stuff with polyfil to desired fullness, making sure to tuck polyfil tightly into the corners and ears!
9. Turn opening edges to the inside and hand or machine stitch closed.
