

# Cozy Cushions

**PFAFF®**



## Sewing Supplies Cushion 1

- Sewing thread in olive and pink
- Machine embroidery thread in pink
- Textile glue
- Floral print fabric for cushion cover: 42 cm x 102 cm (17 x 40 inches)
- Checked fabric for pocket: 12 cm x 17 cm (4 3/4 x 6 3/4 inches)
- Pink velvet ribbon: 40 cm (16 inches)

## Instructions

1. Machine embroider (e.g. with the PFAFF® creative™ 4.0 sewing and embroidery machine) the child's name in the center of the fabric piece for the small pocket.
2. Cut the floral print fabric to the size needed for the cushion cover. Use straight pins to mark the pocket position on the front section of the fabric.
3. Turn each edge of the pocket piece to the wrong side, 1 cm (3/8 inch) wide, press, and stitch in place. Pin the pocket piece to the cushion cover piece as marked. Stitch side and lower edges of pocket in place, stitching 0.5 cm (3/16 inches) from edges.
4. Cut velvet ribbon to match side and lower edges of pocket. Glue the ribbon lightly over these edges with textile glue. Edgestitch both edges of the ribbon in place.
5. Sew a cushion cover with envelope back.

## Sewing Supplies Cushion 2

(cover with envelope back)

- For a cushion measuring 40 x 40 cm (16 x 16 inches), you will need a piece of fabric measuring 43 x 110 cm (17 x 44 inches). For a cushion measuring 50 x 50 cm (20 x 20 inches), you will need
- 53 x 130 cm (21 x 51 inches) of fabric.
- In addition you will need: sewing thread in color to match the fabric, measuring tape, scissors, iron, needle, and straight pins



## Instructions

1. Hem the narrow ends of the fabric piece (these will be the edges of the envelope back). To do this, fold each narrow edge to the wrong side, twice 2.5 cm (1 inch) wide, press, and pin. Edgestitch this double hem in place.



2. Fold the narrow ends onto the fabric piece, one after the other, with right side of the fabric facing in. The narrow edges overlap by approx. 1.5 cm (6 inches) and the folded fabric now forms a square to match the size of the cushion. Pin side edges closed, through all layers.



3. Stitch 1.0 cm (3/8 inch) from each side edge, thereby closing it. Finish edges of seam allowances.



4. Turn the cushion cover right side out and press the seamed edges. Pull the cover over the cushion.



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
